Keeping balloon between the legs and reaching finishing line.

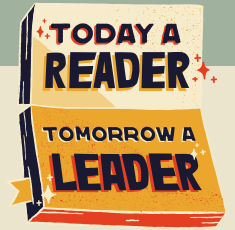
Benefits : Fun + balance and coordination also works on sensory coordination.

WHAT WE LEARNT THIS MONTH



LITERACY

- Introduction of the basic strokes- standing line and sleeping line.

Activities:

- Tracing standing line and sleeping line on sand, salt and sand paper.
- Rainbow writing of standing line and sleeping line with different colored crayons.
- Practice sheets on standing line and sleeping line.



NUMERACY

- Introduction of the shapes- circle, square, rectangle and triangle through rhymes
- Practice sheets on shapes- circle, square, rectangle and triangle.

Activities:

- Tracing circle shape using different colors.
- Collage activity in a square shape.
- Making a rectangle shape with play dough.
- Sorting the different shapes.



UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD



Theme – Sounds Around Us

- Nature walk to explore outdoor sounds. It can help a child to focus their attention and take in the details of things around them.
- Identification of different sounds from our surroundings.
- Identification of different animals and birds by listening to the audio clip.
- Identification of the basic colors of our surroundings.

WELLNESS

- Introduction of basic physical activities such as running, jumping
- Sit-ups long with hula hoops circuit run.
- Fundamental movement skills: horizontal, vertical movements.
- Jumps and balancing skills using hurdles followed by sprinting
- Animal movement – frog jumps and running

ART , CRAFT & CLAY MODELLING

- Drawing of a caterpillar

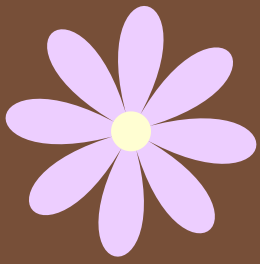
Take away:
